Daycare rates 2023 - explained.

- The government rate for daycare is € 8,97 per hour. This is the amount used to calculate the childcare allowance from the Tax Authorities.
- Additional childcare is possible, but depends on staff scheduling and the relevant legislation. You pay the rate associated with your contract for this.
- Daycare is provided in full-day units (7:30 18:30). Some locations also offer half-days. A morning half-day is from 7:30 to 13:00 and an afternoon half-day is from 13:00 to 18:30. Several locations offer early opening times or extended opening hours. Ask your customer adviser about the options.
- The 40-week package is billed 11 times a year. August will not be billed.
- For the twelve weeks of school holidays, we are in line with the official school holidays for state region South. During holiday times, we may combine groups, and childcare may be provided at different locations.
